59438	NY	In certain situations, when an over midnight payment ends in a split week, the first week of the next month calculates as a negative amount.	Corrected an issue with the payment calculator.
59453	NY	The new market rates have changes to the age categories for Family, Group Family and Legally Exempt provider types. The system needed to be modified to handle both the new, and existing age categories.	<p>Modified the age categories by splitting the 1 1/2 thru 2 category into separate 1 1/2 to 2 and 2 to 3 categories.</p> <p>For Day Care Centers, School Age Programs and Legally Exempt Group provider types, the market and provider rates listed in the 1 1/2 - 2 category will need to be entered into the 1 1/2 to 2 and 2 to 3 age categories in CCTA.</p> <p>For all other provider types, the market and provider rates listed in the Under 2 age category will need to be entered into the Under 1 1/2 and the 1 1/2 to 2 age categories in CCTA.</p> <p>A script has been run to change all existing market and provider rates so that they fit into these categories.</p> <p>In addition, the new Market Rates effective 6/1/16 have been entered for all districts.</p>
